

**If ANY chemistry courses are full, such as:
Chem. 1A/B/C, Chem. 1AL/BL/CL,
Chem. 109A/B/C, Chem. 6A/B/C**

YOU MUST CRASH THE COURSE

The Undergraduate Advisor cannot give you an approval code.

To CRASH the course you must:

1. Attend every lecture or lab you are trying to add, and continue doing so until you are either given an approval code, or until you are told that the class is full and no more students will be added. To crash a lab you may want to attend more than one section, until you receive an approval code.

2. Obtain an approval code for:

- lectures from the Professor
- labs from the Teaching Assistants

3. If applicable, place your name on a “waiting list” or “approval code list” if a list exists with your TA or Professor. Prior to the start of the quarter, check the UCSB online waiting list web site (<https://waitlist.ucsb.edu/>) for Chemistry and Biochemistry Department waiting lists.

4. Remember that signing up on the waiting list or crashing the class does not guarantee you a spot in the class. If a Professor says the class is full and will not add any more students, you will need to take the class at a later time.
